Holy, Holy, Holy

I try to get my head around the word “holy” describing God and it is like me trying to understand Einstein’s Theory of Relativity, times infinity, plus one!

Any human description of how holy or how pure God is comes out lame. I can no more describe His purity and holiness than I can describe His vastness and might. Scientists do not easily grasp or describe the expanse of the heavens - galaxy upon galaxy - and *He created them!* Only a holy God could create the heavens, the seas, the world, our bodies, by speaking them into existence, and then holding them together.

The closest I come to grasping God’s holiness (and it is a miniscule grasp) is when I read Revelation 4:8 where the angels “do not rest, day or night, saying “Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come”. This they say, day and night; the same 14 words repeated day and night. They get it! I do not have the capacity to worship God to such an extent, nor can I grasp the immensity of such holiness. I want to use words like huge, and enormous, and vast - but describing something beyond worldly experience immediately exerts limits, and God is limitless; and His holiness is limitless.

Which makes the terms of my salvation even greater. God’s Holy Spirit draws me to Him, allowing me, in my unholy condition, to stand in His holy presence.

I, an unholy being,
admitted into the presence of a holy God,
to save me from eternal damnation,
to spend a glorious sin-free existence with Him,
unbounded by time and space.
